




Front-flip Horse [A4 size 6 pages]


A wide range of different origami has been enjoyed in Japan since ancient times.

When you flick the tail upward, this Front-flip Horse will do a flip in midair and land on its feet.


The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.



Fold in half along line (A).




Unfold the triangle back to its original position.




Fold the lower triangle upward along line ©




Flatten out the folds.




Fold in half again along line B.



Flatten the triangle to obtain a square.



Flatten out the folds.




Fold the lower right triangle in half, folding upward along line D.


Continue on to page 2.

Open up the triangle.


Crease the fold, then unfold the triangle back to its original position.


Flatten out the folds.










Turn over.


Rotate the model so that the bottom point is on top.




Fold the lower right triangle upward along line 1. Repeat with the

lower left triangle along line 1.


Fold and crease along line and, then unfold the paper back to its original position.



Cut the top layer along the cut line, in the same manner.




Fold and crease along line Gand 11, then unfold the paper back to its original position.



Cut the top layer along the cut line, then turn the model over.














The horse will do a front-flip in midair.
